A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF AN ARPA HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES GRANT APPLICATION TO THE WYOMING STATE LAND AND INVESTMENT BOARD ON BEHALF OF SOUTH CENTRAL WYOMING EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES FOR THE PURPOSE OF BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTION TO ERECT AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES STATION FACILITY IN HANNA, WYOMING.

WHEREAS, South Central Wyoming Emergency Medical Services Joint Powers Board (SCWEMS) desires to participate in the HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES CAPITAL CONSTRUCTION ARPA GRANTS program to assist in financing this request; and

WHEREAS, South Central Wyoming Emergency Medical Services Joint Powers Board (SCWEMS) recognizes the need for the request; and

WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Capital Construction ARPA Grant program requires that certain criteria be met, as described in the State Loan and Investment Board's Rules and Regulations governing the program, and to the best of our knowledge this application meets those criteria; and

WHEREAS, if any of the disbursed grant funds are later deemed to not comply with the SLIB criteria or the criteria of the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA), the grant applicant agrees to repay the ineligible grant funds within 15 days of such finding to the Office of State Lands and Investments.

WHEREAS, participating in this program would add value to South Central Wyoming Emergency Medical Services and state of the art capabilities to the residents served.

BE IT RESOLVED, we the Participating Agencies of South Central Wyoming Emergency Medical Services grant the authorities to participate in the State Land Investment Board ARPA Health and Human Services Capital Grant by submitting application, accepting grant monies offered, and all other necessary requirements to fulfill this grant process.

NOW THEREFORE THE TOWN OF SARATOGA, WYOMING RESOLVES, to participate in the State Land and Investments Board ARPA Health and Human Services Grant Application.
