

# Water and Wastewater Operator Level – I or Operator in Training Open Position

## Example of Duties

- Knowledge of the principles, methods, techniques, equipment and materials common to water / wastewater systems maintenance repair.
- Knowledge of water / wastewater testing and treatment techniques.
- Knowledge of the hazards and safety precautions common to water / Wastewater operations.
- Skill in the use and operations of a backhoe.
- Ability to perform moderate heavy tasks for extended periods of time in all kinds of weather.
- Ability to follow verbal and written instructions.
- Ability to keep accurate records.
- Requires that individual to be on call 7 days a week, 24hrs a day on a rotating schedule with other operators. May be called out at any time for emergencies.
- Can be called to assist in any job performed by the Department of Public Works staff.

## Experience:

- Preferred one (1) year of experience as, or in, a position equivalent to Water / Wastewater Operator I.
- Preferred one (1) year experience operating medium size equipment including, but not limited to, backhoe, loader, dump truck, farm tractor and skid steer.
- Preferred individual with current CDL or willing to obtain a CDL.

## Education:

- Proof of High School graduation or equivalent.

## Necessary Special requirements:

- Must be 18 years or older.
- Possession of a valid Wyoming Driver's License.
- Possession of, or ability to obtain within one year of hire, an appropriate Wyoming water / Wastewater license (Level I Water / Distribution, and Level I Wastewater / Collection).
- Successfully pass a preemployment alcohol and drug test as well as random alcohol and drug tests.
